[New] Garden Spaces




A most sincere thank you to parents JoAnn Cox and Lindsay Falewicz for thier tireless efforts on behalf of our garden spaces. Our **Peace Garden** will be 90% complete this week! The funds for this space came from our last Bee Hive event, with a \$1000 donation from City Realty. We also had 5 yards of compost delivered from City of Boston, and a shed has been donated by Eastie Farms. All plants in gardens currently were donated by various community members. The Alighieri recently a gift of \$250 to support our **Forgiveness Garden**, inspired by one of this year's Social Justice texts, and we found out this weekend that Mr. Achala and LIndsay's grant proposal for an additional \$250 was accepted, which will allow us to complete the project. Funds from last year's Scholastic Book Fair will be used to purchase a reading bench for this space, which is also located near our Little Free Library.


